You could have different rooms set up as different countries. Have an activity in each different room.

Activity suggestions:

- Mexico – make or play drums, maracas – could be a craft or a residents music time.
- France – Read poems, taste non-alcoholic wine or French decaf coffee with mini croissants
- Hawaii – Body movement class – play music for hula dancing or the pompom shakers to do a hand type dance for the movement of the arms.
- England – Have a royal tea time
- Egypt – Visit the pyramids and read some crypt writings
- Have short film clips or show a travel movie
